ANTIQUÉ BOAT SHOW GUIDELINES

- Please make special requests in writing and early so that we can do our best to accommodate
- All entrants should bring adequate lines and fenders. Weather on the river can be severe. Your boat is your responsibility.
- Security will be provided, but you need to secure your belongings for safe keeping, only owner of registered boat will be allowed on the docks each day after boat Show closes at Sunset.
- Please send a photograph of your boat with your registration to be used in program and for judging. **Photo deadline August 1 2010**
- Smoking is prohibited near display areas
- All registered entries **MUST** remain on display until the Awards Luncheon for the benefit of our spectators who are visiting the show thru out the three day event. A pull ticket will be given, giving you a breakdown and departure time. This is done to ensure safety and orderly set up and break down of event. This will be given to you by the site manager with your break down and exiting instructions.

JUDGING GUIDELINES AND TIPS

- All entries to be judged **MUST** be in operable condition
- 60% of wooden boats planks, hull and deck material [not including the bottom] **MUST** be original to be considered "Preserved"
- Preserved/ Restored does not apply to contemporary classifications
- Classification -Historic is built before 1919
- Classification- Antique built between 1919 and 1942
- Classification- Classic Built between 1943 and 1975
- Classification- Early contemporary built between 1976 and 1983
- Classification -Late contemporary built between 1984 and 2010
- Classification- Pre War Utility
- Classification-Post War Utility

- Bonus Points will be given for attractive documentation, designed for the boat show attendee to learn more about your boat
